## 65 & Older

Taxpayers that are 65 and over or are disabled and have applied for and received the 65 and older/disabled exemption will not see an increase in their taxes for residential homestead values above the frozen levy amount, as established when the exemption was granted for their existing homestead, except for improvements made after the exemption was granted.

## Voter qualifications

Must be a registered voter with current address in the district. Must be a resident at least 30 days prior to election. The deadline to register to vote is October 7, 2019.

## New Intermediate School

Provide additional capacity for elementary and intermediate school students

## Intermediate School Re-purposing



Convert existing school into a testing center, daycare for district staff, office space for migrant and special education staff, and classrooms for the FSISD alternative education program



## Elementary School Renovations

Renovate 1960s-era classrooms and restrooms at Apache. Replace flooring, and renovate music room and library at Alamo.

## High School Additions & Renovations



Replace the fieldhouse, construct a new career and technology classroom building, and renovate the library and auditorium curtains, rigging, and dressing rooms
