

ORDINANCE

An ordinance levying an annual ad valorem tax for the year 2021, setting specific tax rates, applicable to all real, personal, and mixed property situated within Fort Stockton Independent School District, setting the date and providing for penalties and interest on delinquent taxes.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees for the Fort Stockton Independent School District of Fort Stockton, Pecos County, Texas:


That an ad valorem tax rate of **\$1.1289** per \$100 cash valuation, be and the same is hereby levied for the year 2021 on all real property, personal property, and mixed property located and situated within the confines and boundaries of Fort Stockton Independent School District as of January 1 of this year.

That the above specified ad valorem tax rate be distributed as follows:


- A. **\$0.8792** rate for the Maintenance and Operations fund.
- B. **\$0.2497** rate for debt service, bonded indebtedness, and interest and sinking fund

Any person failing to pay their taxes on or before January 31 shall be subject to the maximum penalties thereon allowed by law to be collected on delinquent taxes. All delinquent taxes shall bear interest at the highest per annum interest rate allowed by law to be collected on delinquent taxes and shall bear interest from the date of delinquency until paid.
